Meet Information Guidelines

- Entry Deadline:** Online entries will open 8:00am May 8th, 2011 and remain open until 11:59 PM Sunday, May 29th, 2011. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Upon declaration of online registration, please mail your entry fee and postmarked by May 30th, 2009. **(ONLY ON-LINE REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED – THERE WILL BE NO MEET DAY REGISTRATIONS)**
- Entry Procedure:** **Individuals/unattached relays:** Entries must be completed ON-LINE using the following ASIP link on Heartland Athletic Services website www.heartlandathleticservices.com Once entries are declared and completed, payment will be due. Entries and events may be changed or updated until you declare or up to the deadline date; at which point entries will be final and no changes will be allowed. The entry fee charged will be calculated based on the number of athletes/relays and events entered. Entry fees are non-refundable. **Mail a copy of your declared entry and fees to: Heartland Athletic Services Inc., P.O. Box 30074, Kansas City, MO 64112.** (Make checks payable to Heartland Athletic Services, Inc.) **Postmarked by May 30th, 2011**
Club Teams: Entries must be completed ON-LINE using the following ASIP link on Heartland Athletic Services website www.heartlandathleticservices.com Once entries are completed, payment will be due. Entries and events may be changed or updated until you declare or up to the deadline date; at which point entries will be final and no changes will be allowed. The entry fee charged will be calculated based on the number of athletes/relays and events entered. Please do not enter anyone who does not intend to run. Entry Fees are non-refundable. **Mail a copy of your declared entry and fees to: Heartland Athletic Services Inc., P.O. Box 30074, Kansas City, MO 64112.** (Make checks payable to Heartland Athletic Services, Inc.) **Postmarked by May 30th, 2011**
- Event Seeding:** Events will be seeded by entry marks. Enter a mark from the previous season in metric or imperial measurements (outdoor distances and marks will be accepted and converted if necessary). Meet Management will make every effort to seed the events properly. We reserve the right to throw out any marks deemed unrealistic and consider that athlete/relay team entered with no mark. Any athlete who is entered with no mark will be seeded at the bottom of the entry list; therefore, athletes must send in a true and accurate mark. **All heats and seeding of the events will be final once we have published the heat sheets.** (Also, meet management has the right to combine any race in some age divisions.)
- Rules “USATF”:** The USA Track & Field rules will apply.
- Spectator Entry:** Spectators bring your lawn chairs and umbrellas the outdoor seating is limited at Johnson County Community College Track & Field Stadium.. No Spectators allowed on Track. Only Coaches and Athletes allowed on Track.
- Participant Entry:** **Athletes:** Each Athlete will receive a **white wristband** in their packets, which will serve as their pass to participate in the meet, as well as proof that the entry fee has been paid.
Athletes must wear their wristband at all times!

Meet Information Guidelines

- Packet Pick-up:** Before entering the track stadium, locate the packet pick-up area and all athletes and club coaches may pick-up packets between 7:00am and 1:00pm on June 4th. First event starts at 8:30 am. See schedule on page 3.
- Warm-Up Area:** Athletes must warm-up in the assigned areas.
- Check-In:** The clerk of the course is located at the North end of the track near the starting area. Athletes must check-in 20 minutes before their event and will be escorted to the starting line. Field event athletes must check in with the Head Official of their event 30 minutes (60 minutes for PV) prior to the start of their event. **Athletes must present their wristbands at check in or they will not be allowed to compete.**
- Heat Sheets & Results:** Heat sheets and results will be available on-line. Heat sheets will be available on June 1st at www.heartlandathleticservices.com and paper copies will be available at packet pick-up on meet day. Results will be posted after each event in the results/awards area. Final results will be available 20-30 minutes after each final event is completed and they will also be posted on the website listed above the by midnight on June 6th.
- Awards:** The top 3 athletes and relay teams in each event will receive a medal. The 4th through 6th place athletes and relay teams in each event will receive ribbons. Athletes and relay teams may pick up their awards after the results have been posted at the awards area.
- Concessions:** **There will be NO concessions at the meet - Please bring your own FOOD and DRINKS (NO Glass containers allowed in the track stadium facility)**
- Implements:** Meet management will provide certified USATF youth mini javelin & Shot put implements for ages 5-12 only. Athletes must provide their own field event implements including vaulting poles.
- Equipment:** Athletes must use batons provided by the meet management. 1/4 or 1/8 inch spikes are allowed. Starting blocks will also be provided.
- Sanction:** Meet sanction by USA Track & Field
